1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

There were apologies for absence from Diane Lamb.

2. MINUTES of the Annual Meeting of Parishioners held on 24th May 2018 were reviewed, approved and signed by the Chairman.

3. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT FOR COUNCIL YEAR 2018-2019

This was read out by the Chairman.

4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Members of the Public had the following issues to raise:-

- Parking Issues in Hillside Gardens – the Parish Council has no jurisdiction over parking issues but acknowledged that this is a problem in several roads in the village, as well as nationally. This issue will be brought up at the meeting with PS R Reay on 18th June 2019
- Parking Issues outside All Saints' Church – the Parish Council has no jurisdiction over parking issues but agreed to contact the Highways Department at Peterborough City Council and send a copy of the letter to the culprit
- Overhanging Beech Tree at the rear of The Limes – the Parish Council has no jurisdiction over trees on private land
- Church Road Housing Development – the Parish Council agreed to contact the Planning Department at Peterborough City Council and to request that the planning conditions are enforced

- Proposed Scout Hut – Mr & Mrs Amos informed the Parish Councillors of the proposed plan to erect a Scout Hut on land near the allotments (the Chairman declared an Interest as he owns land in the vicinity). The Parish Councillors were supportive of the proposed plan but urged caution and to make sure that all funding was in place before giving any contractors the go-ahead. It was suggested that unused land near Parker Road which is owned by the Parish Council could be an alternative site
