1 Chairman's report:

3 Treasurer report

- Last year the club made a £82,000 loss. This financial year the starting balance was £3,000.
 The current balance is £ 20,788.
- A major contributing factor is the introduction of a card reader for customer payments.

- Planning has begun for future events later in the year; including an Easter party and VE Day commemorations.

5 AOB
